



CAMP RULES

AOWA camps are designed to create a supportive environment for camp participants to enjoy a safe, respectful and fun experience. AOWA appreciates the support of all persons to uphold our camp rules.

Any breach of camp rules may result in you being sent home immediately.

- You must respect the rights and privacy of others at all times.
- You must cooperate with staff and volunteers at all times.
- No electronic devices are permitted at camp. This includes mobile phones, tablets, gaming devices or similar. If devices are found, they will be immediately confiscated and you may be sent home from camp. You can speak with your parents/guardians at any time via the camp coordinators' who carry a phone for this purpose.
- No lollies or junk food are permitted, and you are not permitted to eat in your room.
- No alcohol, no illegal substances, weapons (including knives) are allowed at camp.
- No smoking or vaping is permitted at camp.
- You must not touch anyone's personal property without their permission.
- Any form of bullying, abuse, threatening, or intimidating behaviour is unacceptable.
- No swearing, fighting, disrespectful behaviour, stealing, or damaging property is permitted.
- You are not permitted to leave the camp site, building/dorms, or any activity without the prior permission of the camp coordinators.
- Attendance at all activities is compulsory but you should speak with the camp coordinators or camp nurses if you feel you are unable to participate for any reason.
- You must notify the camp coordinators if you are uncomfortable with any experience, feel unwell or need assistance while at camp.
- Arthritis and Osteoporosis WA have sole discretion to determine whether your behaviour is a breach of the camp rules and will result in you being sent home.
