



CAMP RULES

Our goal is for everyone to have a safe, fun and respectful camp experience. Please follow these rules:

1. Be kind and respectful to everyone at camp.
2. Bullying is not allowed. This includes teasing, excluding others, intimidation, threats, harassment or discrimination.
3. Follow directions from camp staff and volunteers.
4. Tell a staff member straight away if:
 - you feel unsafe or uncomfortable;
 - someone is being bullied or treated unfairly; or
 - you are unwell or need help.
5. No phones or electronic devices (including smart watches, tablets and gaming devices) are allowed. If found, they will be confiscated and you may be sent home. Speak to a staff member at any time if you would like to contact your parents.
6. Respect other people's belongings. Do not take, use or damage property that is not yours.
7. No lollies, junk food or eating in dorm rooms.
8. No alcohol, drugs, smoking, vaping, weapons or dangerous items.
9. Stay with your group and do not leave activities, dorms or camp areas without permission. Attend all activities unless a staff member approves otherwise.
10. No fighting, swearing at others, or unsafe behaviour. Help make camp safe, friendly and inclusive for everyone.

Important

If you do not follow these rules it may result in your parents/guardians being contacted and you being sent home. Everyone has the right to feel safe, respected and included at Camp Freedom.
