

Family Fun Day 2026 - Terms and Conditions

Thank you for joining us for the **Arthritis and Osteoporosis W.A. Family Fun Day, in partnership with Western Kids Health**. This event is designed to be a fun, safe, and positive experience for families to enjoy together. We encourage all participants to bring a cheerful, respectful attitude and embrace the spirit of community and fun throughout the day. By attending and participating in the event, you agree to be bound by the following **Terms and Conditions**. Please read these carefully before taking part in the event. Your participation indicates acceptance of these terms.

1. **Assumption of risk:**

Participation in the Family Fun Day involves various activities that may include physical movement, games, and interactive events. While every reasonable effort will be made to ensure safety, participants acknowledge that there are inherent risks associated with physical activities, such as falls, collisions, or accidents. By attending the event, you voluntarily assume all risks related to your participation, as well as that of your children, and agree to hold Arthritis and Osteoporosis W.A., partners and contractors harmless in the event of any injury, damage, or loss.

2. **Supervision of children:**

- **General supervision:** Parents and guardians are fully responsible for supervising their children at all times during the event. Arthritis and Osteoporosis W.A. is not responsible for the care or supervision of children unless otherwise stated. Parents or guardians must remain with their children throughout the event to ensure their safety.
- **Activity-specific supervision:** For certain activities where parents are not directly involved, supervision will be provided by Arthritis and Osteoporosis W.A. staff, volunteers and those from external organisations facilitating the activities. By allowing your child to participate in these activities, you acknowledge that Arthritis and Osteoporosis W.A. will take all reasonable measures to ensure the safety of children involved but parents/guardians must understand that Arthritis and Osteoporosis W.A. cannot be held liable for any issues arising outside the scope of direct supervision during this activity. You are able to supervise your children should you be uncomfortable with this.

3. **Health and care needs of children:**

Parents or guardians are responsible for managing their child's health and care needs during the event, including, but not limited to, food allergies, other allergies, mobility requirements, and emotional support. If your child has any specific health concerns or care needs, you must ensure that they are adequately managed, and that staff are informed, where necessary. Arthritis and Osteoporosis W.A. will not be responsible for any health-related issues that arise during the event.

4. **Liability waiver:**

By attending and participating in the Family Fun Day, all participants (including parents, guardians, and children) agree to release and hold harmless Arthritis and Osteoporosis W.A., its volunteers, employees, contractors, and affiliates from any liability for injury, loss, or damage arising out of participation in the event. This waiver includes claims for negligence or any other form of liability, except where prohibited by law.

5. Medical emergencies and consent:

In the event of a medical emergency, Arthritis and Osteoporosis W.A. will make every effort to contact the designated emergency contact immediately, should it be necessary. By participating, you consent to Arthritis and Osteoporosis W.A. seeking emergency medical treatment for you or your child, if necessary, in the event of an injury or medical need, including but not limited to administering first aid or calling for an ambulance. You agree that this consent is given in the absence of a parent or guardian should the situation require immediate attention.

6. Photographs and media consent:

By attending the Family Fun Day, you grant Arthritis and Osteoporosis W.A. permission to capture photographs, video recordings, and other media throughout the event. These materials may be used for promotional, marketing, and social media purposes. If you do not wish to be photographed or recorded, you must inform event staff prior to the event. Arthritis and Osteoporosis W.A. will make reasonable efforts to accommodate your wishes.

7. Behaviour and code of conduct:

In the spirit of fun and community, all participants are expected to behave respectfully and responsibly while attending the event. Any disruptive, unsafe, or inappropriate behaviour, whether by children, parents, or guests, will not be tolerated. Arthritis and Osteoporosis W.A. reserves the right to remove any individual or group from the event at its sole discretion if they fail to adhere to these terms and the event's code of conduct.

8. Event modifications and cancellations:

Arthritis and Osteoporosis W.A. reserves the right to modify, cancel, or reschedule any aspect of the Family Fun Day, including activities or the event in its entirety, in the event of unforeseen circumstances such as adverse weather conditions, safety concerns, or other emergencies. In such cases, participants will be notified promptly, and alternatives or rescheduled dates will be offered where possible. Arthritis and Osteoporosis will refund any attendance fees/charges to participants.

9. Compliance with local laws and regulations:

All participants are required to comply with applicable Australian laws, including health and safety regulations, during the event. This includes following COVID-19 safety protocols (if applicable), adhering to event staff instructions, and ensuring the safety and well-being of all involved. Failure to comply with any of these requirements may result in removal from the event.

10. Acknowledgment of terms:

By attending and participating in the Family Fun Day, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agree to the above **Terms and Conditions**. These terms constitute a legal agreement between you and Arthritis and Osteoporosis W.A., and any breach of these terms may result in the participant and/or family members being asked to leave the event.
